**ORDER GOVERNING THE FILING OF PROOF OF RECEIPT OF AND/OR
PATERNITY TEST RESULTS**


This action is an action establish paternity and the possibility exists that paternity testing has been or will be requested. The Superior Court of DeKalb County requires that proof of receipt of paternity test results concerning the minor child or children who are the subject of this action shall be filed with the Court by DCSS. Actual paternity test results shall not be filed with the Court.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that proof of receipt of any paternity test results taken as a result of the filing of this action must be filed with the Court in the action for which the test was taken but not the actual paternity test results. The Department may file proof of receipt of the paternity testing by way of affidavit.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event actual paternity test results are filed, they shall be filed under seal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this Order be filed with each and every child support action filed by the **Georgia Department of Human Services** in which paternity of a child or children is at issue at the time of filing or becomes an issue during the pendency of the case.
